

Angling Improvement Fund - Form Questions

Sections 1 & 2

- Title of your project & confirmation it is based in England
- Summary of your project – Provide details to highlight what the project is addressing, what you intend to do and the benefits the project will bring.
- Details of the main contact person
- Name, location and details of the project venue

Sections 3 & 4

- Need for the project – Explain any evidence you have of the predation your project is seeking to address, what measures you already have in place and how urgent the work is.
- Attach any supporting evidence and explain what they are
- Explain any expert advice you have sought or been given and if available attach the evidence of their support for your project

Section 5

- Explain how you intend to deliver the project giving as much information as you can
- State if there are any planning permissions needed
- Confirm that you can complete the project by the deadline

Sections 6 & 7

- Describe what benefits the project will bring
- Describe what maintenance program you have designed in order keep the facilities maintained and to a good standard
- If you have a development plan for the fishery/venue, please describe any improvements you have already made and what your future are

Section 8

- Estimate the number of angling visits to the venue in the past 12 months
- Estimate how many of these visits are at risk by not doing the project
- Estimate how many new angling visits might be generated by doing the project

Section 9

- Project Costs - list the items, materials and costs needed to do the project
- Enter the amount and source of any monetary contribution you are making towards the project
- List the non-financial/in-kind contributions/donations you will be making towards the project
