# Policy and Procedures 2019

## **ANTI-DOPING POSITION STATEMENT**

The Angling Trust condemns, and is totally opposed to, the use of performance enhancing drugs and doping practices in angling. The Angling Trust works with UK Anti-Doping (UKAD) and the International Angling Confederation (CIPS) to ensure the integrity of our sport is protected. The use of performance enhancing drugs and other doping behaviour severely damages the legitimacy of angling and undermines the integrity of the sport.

An Anti-Doping rule violation shall be considered a breach of the Angling Trust's Codes of Conduct and of the UK Anti Doping Rules.

The use, possession and/or trafficking of banned substances, methods or the encouragement or counselling to use banned substances, or methods; and/or taking measures to mask the use of banned substances or methods by a participant in competitions or matches over which the Angling Trust has jurisdiction is unacceptable and will not be tolerated.
