


## Attended delivery Level 2: how the course is structured



You work together with your tutor and the others in your group, to demonstrate, observe, discuss and share ideas. You'll have a coursework portfolio and resources booklet.



You attend the assessment day and submit your session plans, risk assessments, evaluations and coursework to the tutor.

### Additional requirements for certification at Level 2

- ▶ A current First Aid certificate for training that meets or exceeds the stated minimum criteria (please see separate guidance)
- ▶ A current certificate for **UK Coaching** Safeguarding & Protecting Children training (please see separate guidance)

Please note that your Safeguarding must be undertaken through UK Coaching as we don't normally accept certificates from other training providers.

Likewise your First Aid should be either the particular online course specified and approved by Angling Trust, or a face-to-face assessed course leading to a certificate with a stated validity period or expiry/renewal date.

**Ideally you should aim to complete both sets of training before delivering your four linked coaching sessions and assessment.**

DBS checking isn't required for taking a coaching qualification, but there will be information about this when we invite you to take up your free first year of coach licensing after qualifying at Level 2. If you already hold a Level 1 licence (either current or recently expired), converting that to Level 2 is usually quick and simple.
