

Loch Style Team Championship 2021

Covid-19 Safety Protocols

This document highlights the measures and modifications we will implement to ensure the competition is compliant with best practice guidelines.

1. Briefing
 - a. Emailed to captains Wed week of match.
 - b. Captains share with team members.
 - c. Match day briefing with captains only (AT & Fishery staff).
2. Parking
 - a. Outside lodge – team captains only.
 - b. Main car park – all other participants.
3. Face coverings
 - a. At all times indoors – tackle shop, toilets, café etc.
 - b. All anglers when boats motoring?
 - c. Stewards must always use masks during the sessions, unless exempt.
4. Sanitiser
 - a. Pack of wipes for each boat – angler wipe after each session (provided).
 - b. All Anglers bring their own hand sanitiser.
5. Results management
 - a. Steward only person to touch the measure.
 - b. Anglers present the fish in the net.
 - c. Stewards only person to handle & sign score card.
 - d. Angler must check score recorded & signed by steward (visual check after each fish).
 - e. staff to collect cards on jetty after each session.
6. No Presentation – to avoid a gathering & comply with WWFA guidance
 - a. No post-match food or presentation (Presentation will follow post event).
 - b. Publish results on Facebook and via direct email.
 - c. Rearranged presentation within 2 weeks of event.
7. Start & end of session
 - a. Use both jetties – subject to use by sailing club.
 - b. Fishery staff to manage flow of boats docking and leaving to minimise amount of people on jetty at any one time.
 - c. Officials to collect score cards for each boat on the jetty (stood at gateway).
