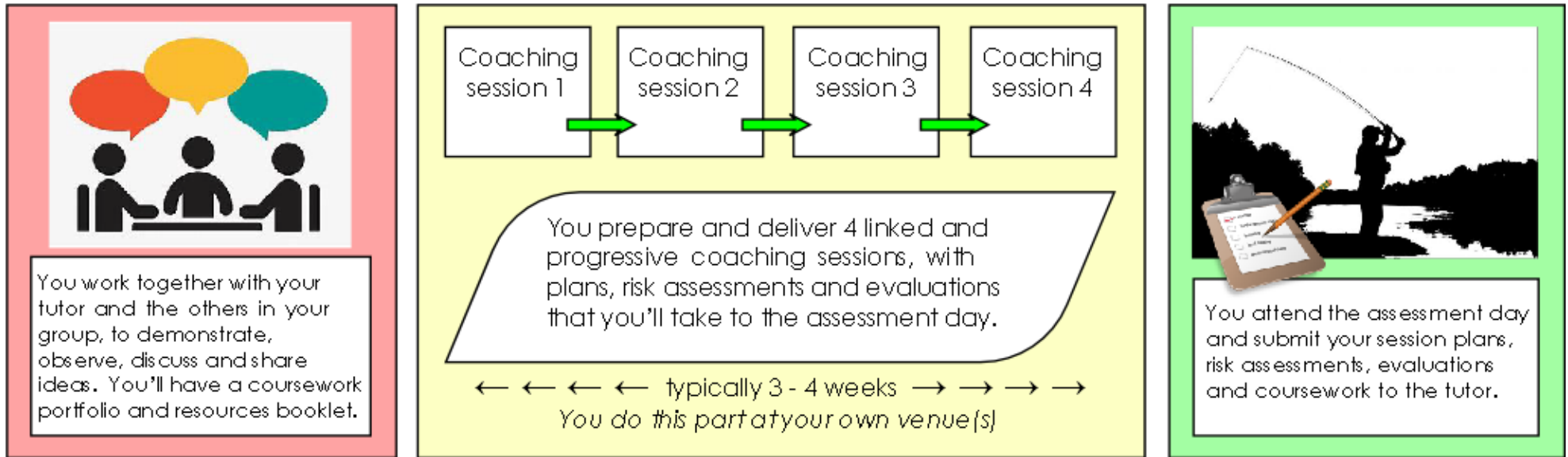


Angling Event Lead Coach: how the course is structured



Planning and delivering your linked and progressive coaching sessions

You will be required to plan and deliver **four linked and progressive coaching sessions** at a time and place of your own choosing (for example with a club or project to which you belong) and with the assistance/involvement of a Lead Coach.

During the foundation sessions of your course (Days 1-2) your tutor will deal with the principles and preparations involved in setting up and delivering your four linked sessions. You set up your linked sessions to put into practice what you've covered on Days 1 and 2.

The tutor for your Angling Event Lead Coach course won't arrange these coaching sessions for/with you or be present to observe them.

You will need to bring the plans, risk assessments, evaluations etc from your four sessions to your final assessment (Day 3 of your AELC course).

Also required before you can be certified as an Angling Event Lead Coach

- ▶ A current First Aid certificate for training that meets or exceeds the stated minimum criteria (please see separate guidance)
