

- Access to our Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) who can offer support/guidance in responding to safeguarding concerns for both children and adults
- Welfare Officers in AT clubs and fisheries will receive free Safer Clubs training from the Angling Trust to prepare them for their role in responding to concerns
- The option to sign your club/fishery up to the Angling Trust policies and procedures and have these linked on your website, with support given in implementing these at club/fishery level
- Angling Trust will organise DBS checks for Welfare Officers due to them being in 'regulated activity' within their roles. This means AT clubs/fisheries won't have to organise this process themselves...
- Access to regular forums, additional bespoke training and regional support groups for Welfare Officers to share best practice
- Support in becoming a 'Safe Club' and appearing on the Angling Trust website as a designated Safe Club
