



Angling Trust Anti-Doping Annual Report 2025

With more than 40 Team England squads competing internationally in 2025, this year has focused on strengthening education and awareness of UKAD regulations across all three angling disciplines.

We have summarised below our key anti-doping activities in 2025:

- Promotion of Clean Sport Week (May 2025) with videos showing Team England supporting 'The Next Generation' theme and shared via our YouTube channel and social media.
- Met with Team England managers to discuss updates to WADA prohibited list and how to check medication through Global DRO website.
- Updated the International Angler Agreement for implementation in 2026.
- All competition entries, at all levels, require the entrant to agree to be bound by and observe the antidoping policies and anti-doping rules of WADA, UKAD and the International Angling Confederation (CIPS).
- Delivered pro-active communications to the Team England members to ensure participants and support staff were fully informed of their responsibilities under the WADA and UKAD rules.
- Issued pro-active communications to all Team England Managers advising of the changes to the Prohibited List 2026, highlighting that the withdrawal of blood or blood components (even without the reintroduction of blood into the circulatory system) will also be prohibited in 2026, unless certain exceptions apply.
- Continued to update and maintain the anti-doping section of the Angling Trust website.
